

ORDINANCE NO. 4003

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE CITY OF EDMONDS COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; ADOPTING THE 2015 UPDATE TO THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND FIXING A TIME WHEN THE SAME SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

WHEREAS, Edmonds, like other cities and counties in our region, must review and update its Comprehensive Plan by the state deadline of mid-2015; and

WHEREAS, as part of the 2015 update, the data that provides the basis for the Comprehensive Plan must be refreshed and the planning horizon extended into the next twenty years, meaning the period of 2015 through 2035, rather than the previous planning horizon from 2005 through 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board held a public hearing on the 2015 Comprehensive Plan on June 10, 2015; and

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2015, the Planning Board voted to recommend adoption of the 2015 Comprehensive Plan, as described in the operative sections below; and

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2015, the City Council held a public hearing on the 2015 Comprehensive Plan; and

NOW THEREFORE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2015 City of Edmonds Comprehensive Plan is hereby adopted to read as set forth in **Exhibit A**, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth herein. This update entirely replaces the 2014 Comprehensive Plan. The 2015 City of Edmonds Comprehensive Plan also includes the elements that are adopted in the sections below.

Section 2. The transportation element of the 2015 City of Edmonds Comprehensive Plan is hereby adopted to read as set forth in **Exhibit B**, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth herein. Exhibit B completely replaces the previous transportation element.

Section 3. The 2015 City of Edmonds Comprehensive Plan shall also include the 2014 Parks Recreation & Open Space Plan, which is hereby readopted to read as set forth in **Exhibit C** hereto, and the 2014 Community Cultural Plan, which is hereby readopted to read as set forth in **Exhibit D** hereto. Exhibit C and Exhibit D are incorporated into the 2015 City of Edmonds Comprehensive Plan, as elements of that plan, by this reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 4. The 2015 City of Edmonds Comprehensive Plan shall also include, as an appendix, the amended 2006 Streetscape Plan, which is adopted to read as set forth in **Exhibit E** attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth.

Section 5. The 2015 City of Edmonds Comprehensive Plan shall also include, as an appendix, the 2015 Street Tree Plan, which is adopted to read as set forth in **Exhibit F** attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth.

Section 6. Section 15.05.000 of the Edmonds Community Development Code, entitled “Adopted,” is hereby amended to read as follows (new text is shown in underline; deleted text is shown in strikethrough):

15.05.000 Adopted.

The City of Edmonds has adopted by ordinance a Comprehensive Plan that provides a policy basis for the development regulations that are codified throughout the Edmonds Community Development Code. The Comprehensive Plan itself is not codified herein, but may be viewed on the City’s website. ~~A. 1997 Amendments Adopted. The 1997 Edition of the Edmonds Comprehensive Plan, attached to the ordinance codified in this section and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full, is hereby adopted as the official comprehensive plan for the city of Edmonds, as required by the Washington State Growth Management Act, Chapter 35.70A RCW. Amendments to the 1995 Edition of the Edmonds Comprehensive Plan are identified by text that is either underlined (denoting new language) or stricken (denoting text that has been deleted). In addition, the 1995 Edition of the Edmonds Comprehensive Plan Concept Map and Figure 9 in the 1995 Edition of the City of Edmonds Transportation Element have been replaced for the 1997 Edition of the Edmonds Comprehensive Plan. Nothing in the 1997 amendment to this section shall be construed as a readoption of the Edmonds Comprehensive Plan in its entirety, or an amendment of any material not identified as an amendment in this section.~~

~~B. Location of Comprehensive Plan Copies. Copies of the 1997 Edition of the Edmonds Comprehensive Plan, including all documents incorporated by reference, shall be maintained on file in the planning department and in the office of the city clerk for inspection by the public.~~

~~C. Attachments to the Comprehensive Plan. The 1997 Edition of the Edmonds Comprehensive Plan adopts several maps, plans and other documents by reference. These documents are incorporated into the comprehensive plan by reference as if set forth in full. These documents include the following:~~
