Last night, January 17, 2015 at around 11:20 pm, a male interrupted a car prowler in the parking lot of 22914 Hwy 99 in Edmonds. The male victim, a 40-year-old employee of Domino's Pizza, confronted the suspect and during the confrontation the suspect stabbed the victim in the abdomen. The suspect then fled on foot. Witnesses called 9-1-1 and Edmonds Police and Fire District 1 aid and medic units immediately responded. The male was transported to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle. The victim was taken into surgery almost immediately upon arrival.

Edmonds Police, with assistance from Lynnwood Police, Mountlake Terrace Police, Snohomish County Sheriff's Office, Mill Creek Police and the Washington State Patrol conducted a K9 track in a search for the suspect. The search did not locate the suspect. Witnesses described the suspect as a mid 20's year old black male, dressed in dark clothing with a backpack. Edmonds Police Detectives responded to the scene and interviewed witnesses and collected evidence. They are continuing the investigation this morning and will be interviewing the victim later today.

At the time of this release the suspect is still outstanding and has not been identified.

There is no further information at this time. The investigation is continuing through the weekend.
